
You want your home to look a certain way and it bothers you that you can never get it to look like you imagine it should. So, you arrange to eat out. You avoid bringing people to see your home.

STEP THREE. PREP AND SELL:


Your home was awesome for your past life. Now, it needs to appeal to many buyers. This is how to get the most money for it.




Accepted offer with Conditions and Inspections met. We can move onto the next step. This is an often overlooked part of the entire process.
